Minimum System Requirements

Before installing the Pearson VUE Tutorial and Practice Exam, make sure your computer meets the system requirements listed below. The software is not designed to install and run properly on systems that do not meet these requirements.

- Pentium III PC or compatible, 1 GHz (Pentium 4, 2 GHz recommended). Macintosh computers are not supported.
- 512 MB of RAM
- 60 MB of empty hard disk space
- Microsoft Windows XP or 2000 (home or professional version), English edition. The content appears only in English.
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 5 or higher
- Super VGA (800 x 600) or higher resolution monitor (1024 x 768 recommended), with high color (16 bit)
- Microsoft compatible mouse or pointing device
- Internet access is not required when viewing the tutorial or demonstration tests.

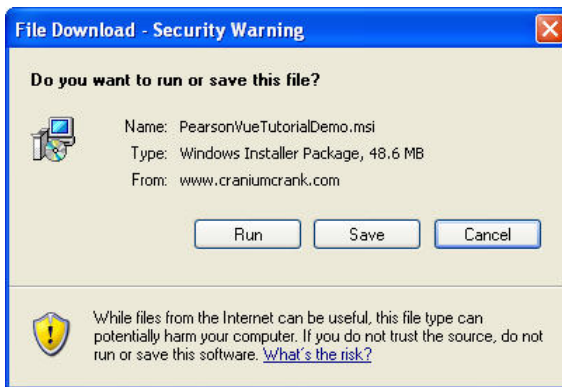
Install the Pearson VUE Tutorial and Practice Exam Software

The installation process is quick and easy. Just follow the instructions on the computer screen. The process is also outlined for you here.

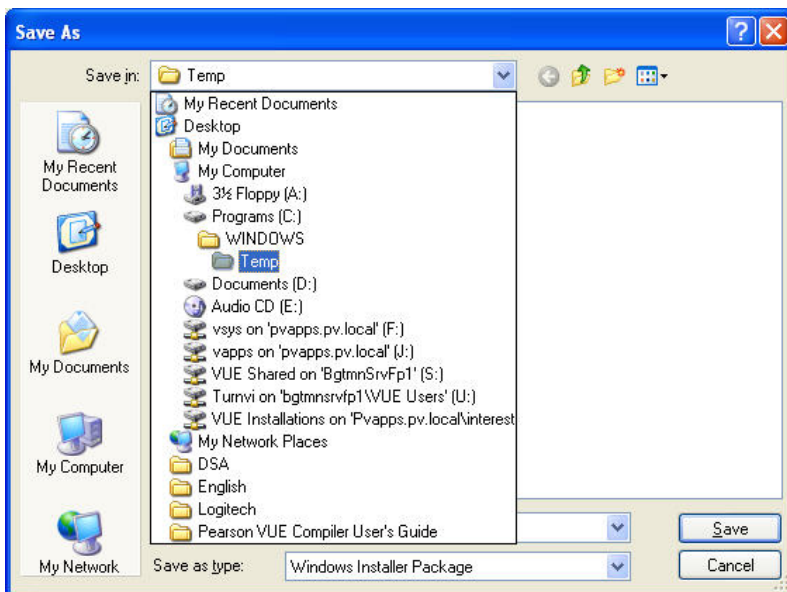
1. Click the **Download Pearson VUE Tutorial and Practice Exam** link on the **Test Taker Services** tab.



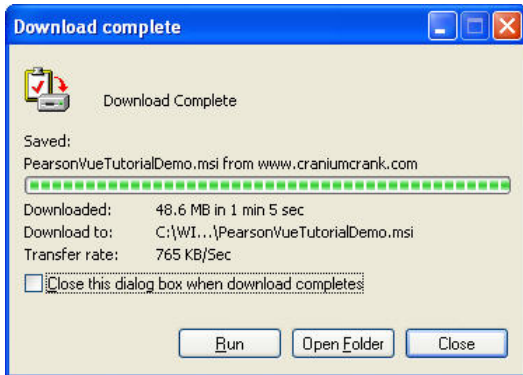
2. Click the **Save** button when the **File Download** window displays.



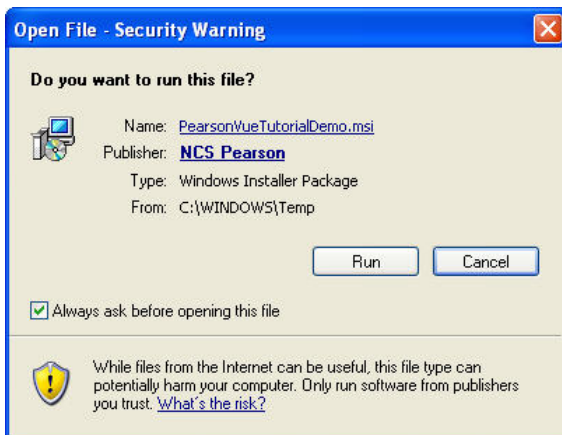
3. The **Save As** window displays. Navigate to the **Temp** directory and click the **Save** button.



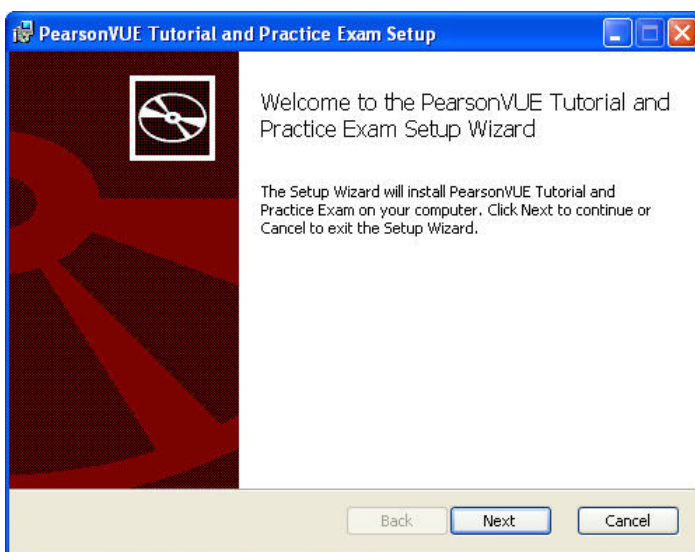
- When the file finishes downloading, the **Download complete** window displays. Click the **Open Folder** button.



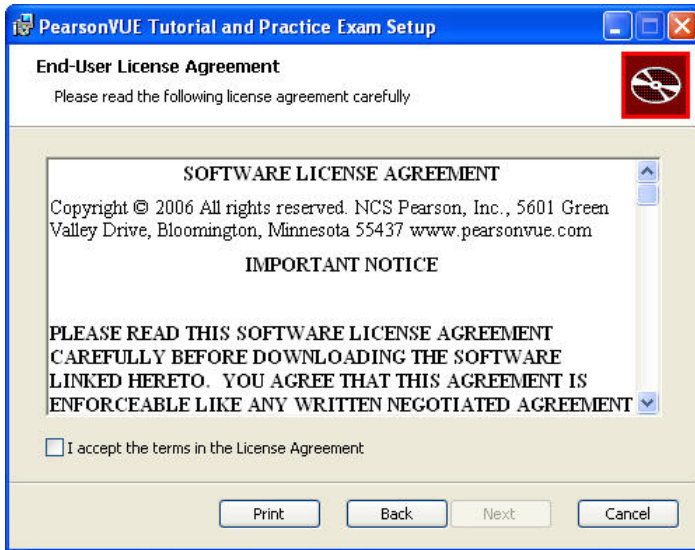
- Double-click the **PearsonVueTutorialDemo.msi** file. The **Security Warning** screen displays.



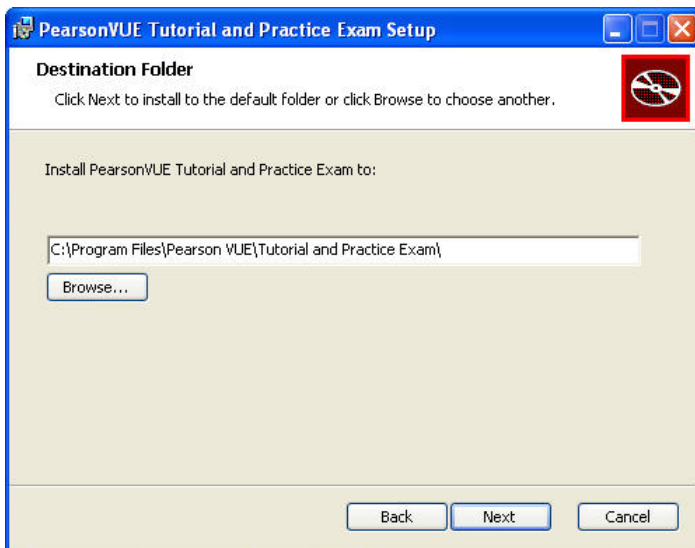
- Click **Run**.
- The **Install Shield Welcome** screen displays. Click **Next**.



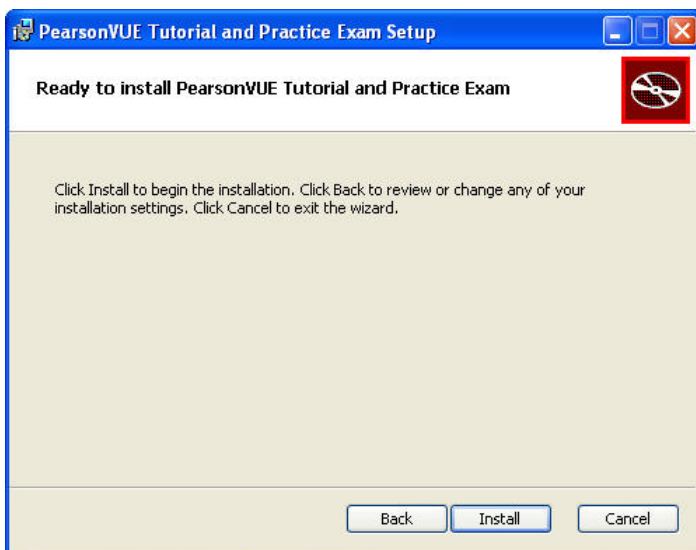
8. The **License Agreement** screen displays. Read the agreement. You can read the agreement on your screen or click **Print** to print a copy.



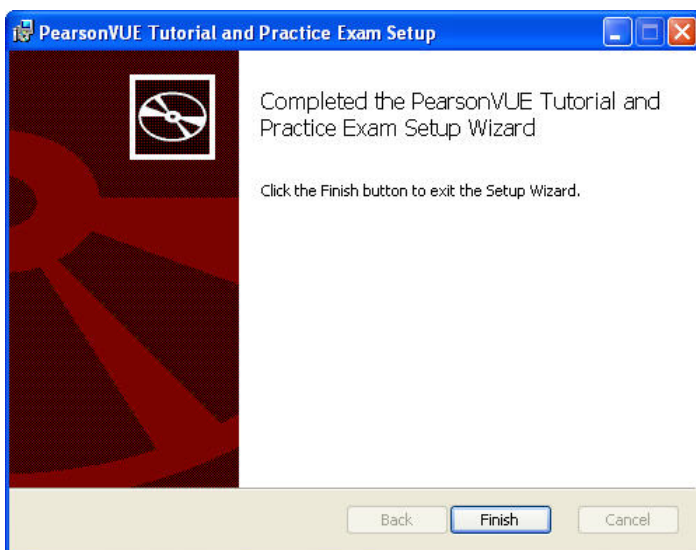
9. If you agree to the terms, select **I accept the terms of the License Agreement** and click **Next**.
(If you do not agree to the terms, click **Cancel** and the Pearson VUE Tutorial and Practice Exam will not load.)
10. The **Destination Folder** screen displays. We recommend that you keep the default location for the tutorial. Click **Next**.



11. The **Ready to install** screen displays. Click **Install**.



12. The tutorial and practice exam installation completes. Click **Finish**. The installation program ends.

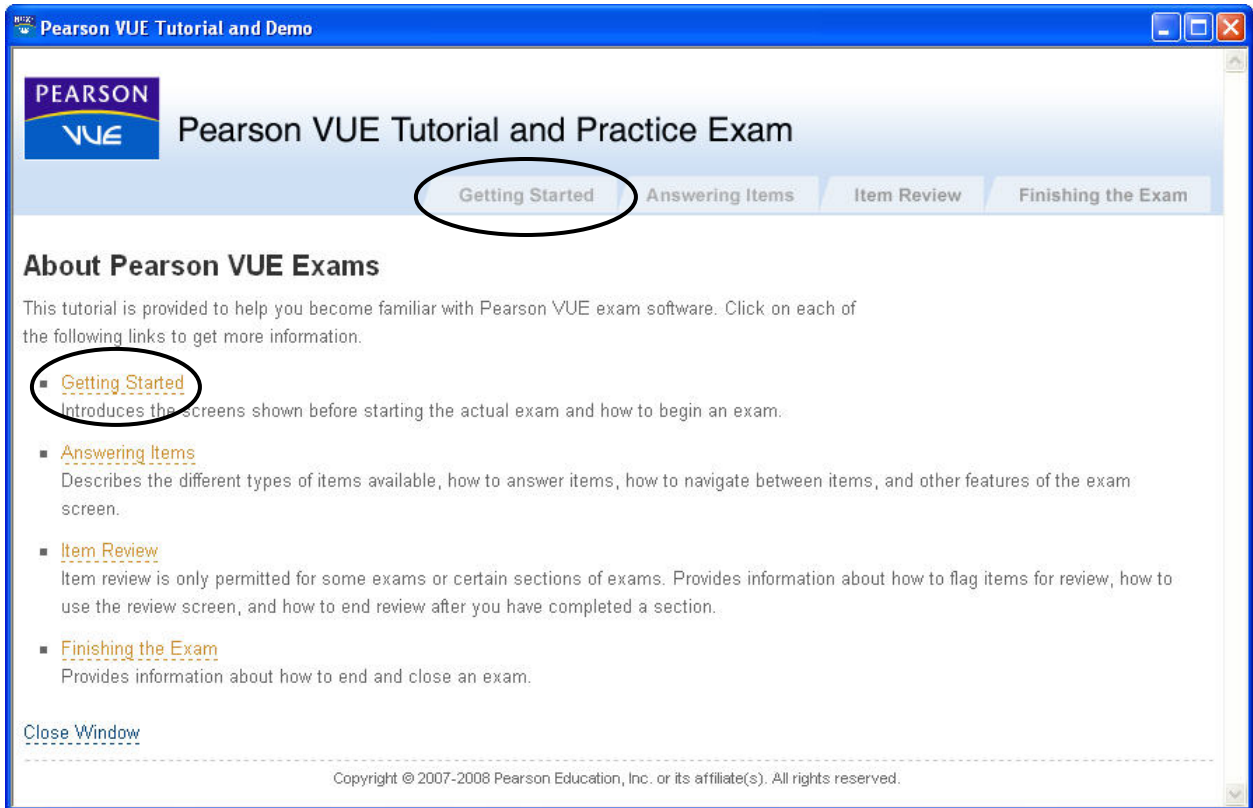
The second part of the tutorial is the "Practice Exam". This will give you a hands on opportunity to become familiar with the operations of computer-based examinations.

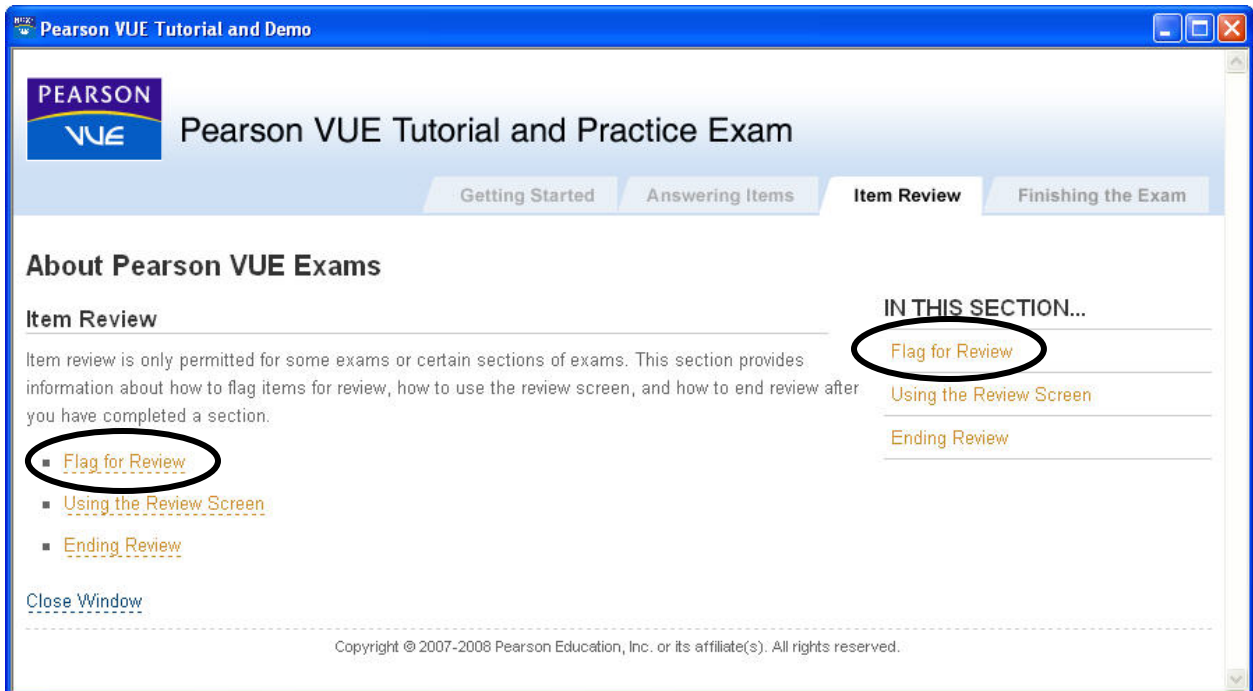

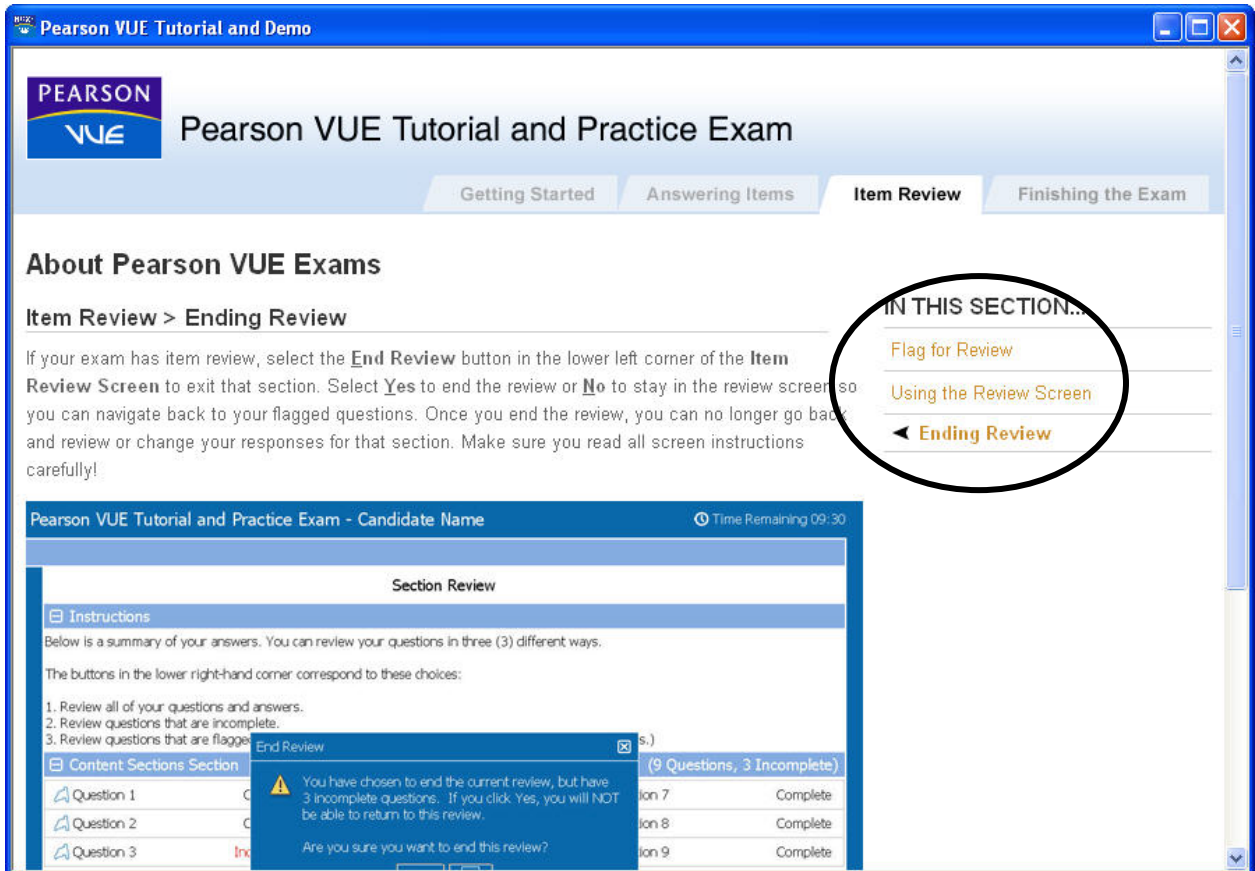
2. The tutorial splash screen displays. Click a **section link** or click the desired **tab** to display a tutorial section.



3. The selected section splash screen displays. Click the **topic link** on the left or the **In this section** link on the right to display the desired topic.



4. Use the **In this Section** links to scroll through the topics in that section of the tutorial.



5. You can close the tutorial at any time. Scroll down to the lower left corner of any tutorial topic and click the **Close Window** link. The Tutorial and Practice Exam splash screen redisplay.

Run Practice Exam

1. Click the **Practice Exam** link.

2. Navigate through the exam using the navigation buttons in the lower right corner of the screen.
