## 5 Easy Steps to Participate in the Comparability Study:

1. Let your local Official GED Testing Center know you are interested in participating in the study. It will provide you with a list of participating Pearson VUE sites that are delivering the computer-based practice tests.
2. Schedule your practice test with the Pearson VUE Call Center at 1-877-392-6433.
3. Show up at your appointment and take the test. You will receive a score report when you have completed the test.

Individuals completing a practice test will be paid. A high score will earn you even more!

4. Take your score report to your local Official GED Testing Center and schedule your paper-and-pencil GED Tests. The Official GED Testing Center will need this report to verify you have completed a practice test.
5. Take your paper-and-pencil GED Tests. That's it!

### How many computer-based GED content area practice tests are available? Can I take more than one test?

There is a computer-based practice test for each of the five GED content areas: Mathematics; Science; Social Studies; Language Arts, Reading; and Language Arts, Writing. Test-takers who are registering to take the GED Tests can take one practice test in every content area.

### Do I have to be an experienced computer user to take the computer-based GED practice tests?

Test-takers with any level of computer experience are encouraged to participate. The computer testing system was designed for those with even minimal computer, typing or keyboarding skills. You may download a computer-based testing tutorial prior to going to the Pearson VUE site and will view it at the site prior to taking the test.

### When will the computer-based GED practice tests be given?

In most cases, whenever a test-taker wants to schedule! The GED practice tests are available during the day, in the evening and on some weekends.

### Where will the computer-based GED practice tests be administered?

Computer-based practice tests are taken at participating Pearson VUE sites. Site locations are available at Official GED Testing Centers.

### When and how do I schedule computer-based practice tests?
