Meet DoD D8570.1M Requirements

In addition to a good career move, CompTIA credentials are a must for certain IT positions. The Department of Defense (DoD) Directive 8570.1M mandates all government personnel, civilians and contractors working on networks to receive industry IT credentials. CompTIA A+, CompTIA Network+ and CompTIA Security+ exams meet Directive 8570.1M requirements and can be taken at any DANTES Pearson VUE test site.

U.S. Military Reimbursement Programs

- GI Bill: Active duty, reserve components, and veterans qualify for reimbursement under the GI Bill. Visit www.GIBill.VA.gov for more details.
- DANTES: Eligible Army Reserve, Army National Guard and Air Force Reserve personnel can apply for reimbursement through the DANTES program. Visit www.DANTES.DoDed.mil for more information.
