



Accessibility Information for Client Proctored - No Appointment Required (CPNAR) exam deliveries

Overview

Client Proctored - No Appointment Required (CPNAR) exam delivery, formerly known as Anywhere Proctored delivery, is a system that enables test sponsors to administer certification tests in any location by using Pearson test delivery software.

CPNAR Systems

CPNAR exam delivery involves three roles: the test sponsor, the test proctor, and the test takers.

Test sponsors and test proctors have individual functions and interact with different web-based applications to support CPNAR exam delivery. Some aspects of the process vary based on the test driver in which the test owner (the client) delivers the exam.

Test takers interact with a separate set of applications to register for, secure, and start the delivery of their exams, as well as with the test driver and exam content.

The following table indicates the applications or sites with which each role interacts.

Role	Applications
Test Sponsor	Navigator, Proctor Management, Private Access Codes
Test Proctor	Navigator, Proctoring, Connection Check (for Pearson test driver deliveries) or System Check (for ITS test driver deliveries)
Test Taker	Client website (for SSO client exams) or Pearson website, Exam Launchpad, and the Pearson or ITS test driver
