

Guidance and Instructions for Completing This Form

- 1. Any candidate aged 16 years and under on the date of their test wishing to take the University of Oxford Admissions Test(s) is required to have the written consent of their parent or guardian before doing so.
- 2. The candidate is also required to be accompanied to their appointment at the test centre by the same parent or guardian who completes the written consent form below. The parent or guardian must remain at the test centre for the duration of the test. Both the candidate and their parent or guardian must present an acceptable form of ID.
- 3. Failure to comply with both points 1 and 2 above will result in the candidate being turned away from their test.
- 4. Section 1 of this form is to be completed by the parent or guardian of the candidate **prior** to their appointment at the test centre and the original signed and completed form must be shown at the test centre. **Only the original form is acceptable, we cannot accept faxed, scanned or photocopied versions**.
