2610	Custom response identifiers for Essay items Authors will be able to customize response identifiers for Essay items. This helps to identify individual responses within items that collect multiple responses from candidates. Project managers can enable or disable this feature in the Essay item template; if enabled, an editable Response identifier field is available when authoring items that use the template. Authors can then customize the response identifier using alphanumeric characters, underscores, or dashes (no other special characters are permitted).
2610	Collections enhancements (Search) The following enhancements are planned for the upcoming release: • Search will support filtering by collections, allowing you to narrow results to items belonging to specific collections. Project managers will be able to create new collections or modify existing collections by adding or replacing items directly from the Search page. • The current "Manage views" page will be enhanced and renamed to "Manage views and collections". Note: Collections within the same item bank must have unique names.
2610	Cancel an in-progress search A Cancel button will be available when performing a search, allowing you to stop long-running search queries. Canceling immediately aborts the active search and clears the progress indicator.
2610	Content glossary for item translations The content glossary will allow item bank managers to define custom term translations (source → target language) to ensure consistent, domain-accurate AI translations across all items. Key features include:

	• Glossary management: Add, edit, and remove translation entries from the Item Bank Configurations > Language Configuration page. Supports one source phrase mapped to multiple target languages. • Glossary-aware translation: The LLM automatically applies the glossary during AI translation, using language-pair prompt templates for consistency. • Source change warnings: Translated items will display a warning when their source item is modified, with an option to re-translate. • Translation without Item Assist: Translation will no longer require Item Assist to be enabled at the project or item bank level.
2610	Cases supported for translation The following capabilities are planned for an upcoming release: • End-to-end case translation: Translating items within a case automatically creates a linked "Case" container in the target language, named <Case Name> (<Language>), across both AI batch translations and JSON imports. • Smart shared exhibit reuse: Automatically detects and reuses existing translated exhibits across questions (including retroactive linking) to avoid duplicate assets. • Direct navigation: A new Translations section in the Case panel provides bidirectional links between source and translated cases in a new tab. • Incremental updates: New questions or exhibits added to an existing case seamlessly append to the existing translated case. • Authoring guardrails: Built-in alerts for partially translated cases, missing translated exhibits, and deletion safeguards on source cases. • Enhanced reporting: Translation error downloads support case-level status tracking and updated Item/Case ID columns.
2610	Prompt preview for item refinement (Item Assist) A Prompt preview button will be added to the Item Assist "Refine Item" workflow, allowing authors and managers to review the exact prompt that will be sent to Item Assist before refining an item. Clicking this button opens a read-only modal showing the fully populated prompt with all placeholders replaced by your actual selected data and metadata.
2610	Essay response "Properties" modal (Authoring) A gear icon next to Essay response fields will open a Properties modal where authors can customize toolbar options, word/character count limits, border styling, and box dimensions.

2610	Item weight configuration for "Drag and drop" templates (dichotomous scoring) Template configurations for dichotomous scoring in Drag and drop items will allow setting default item weights and granting permission for authors to override weights at the item level.
2610	Removal of item-level rubrics support Support for item-level rubrics will be removed from Authoring, QTI building, and reporting. Note: Legacy items containing rubrics will render without errors, ignoring unsupported item rubric data during scoring and delivery.
2610	Historical reviewer information in "reviewers" array (JSON) We are adding a new array in the JSON to show historical reviewer information. Typically, if an item is sent back to an earlier stage in the review workflow, historical information on reviewers is removed from the reviewers array. The array will continue to work this way; however, we are adding a new reviewersHistory array to document this historical information.
2610	Revision comparison tracking for external IDs Updates to an item's External ID will be captured in revision history. When comparing revisions, External ID modifications display inline diff highlights matching other metadata fields.
2611	External ID to become a first-class field External ID is currently used as a comment flag. The External ID field will become a first-class field in the system. This means only unique External IDs can exist within the Item bank. External ID will be updated for both legacy and Authoring editor projects. Users will be able to edit this field within the Metadata area of items. Import of External IDs will still be allowed. Unique External IDs will be enforced throughout the item bank.
TBD	Review workflow settings in Authoring projects Review workflow settings for Authoring projects will be honored. These settings allow reviewers to edit item content, exhibit content, blueprint, references, and/or metadata. Any of these options can be turned on or off for a review state. Currently in Authoring projects, reviewers can edit any exhibit in a review state within the project. The new settings will enable project managers to selectively choose Item content and/or Exhibit content (or neither option) for each review state.

	• If the review state only has Item content selected, users can edit the content of items in that state that are assigned to them. • If the review state has Exhibit content selected, users can edit exhibits that are attached to items within their assignments.
TBD	HTML export for batch actions in search HTML export will be available as a batch action on the Search page, allowing you to export selected items for translation workflows directly from search results. The exported translation HTML file can be imported back to create translated items.
TBD	Context-sensitive in-app help documentation The Help button on newer Navigator-enabled ExamDeveloper pages (Access token, Item Assist settings, Enemy detection, Manage variables, etc.) will open the specific help topic for the current page instead of always opening the generic landing page.
TBD	Deprecate Examinee Data Import page Based on user needs, the "Examinee Data Import" page is no longer needed. This page will be deprecated from all instances of ExamDeveloper.
