Eligibility Criteria

- **Instructor Certification:** Must hold a recognized instructor teaching certification (e.g., MCT, GCAT).
- **Proven Teaching Quality:** Demonstrated positive track record from prior training engagements.
- **Pearson Onboarding Completion:** Complete Pearson's onboarding program.
- **Commitment to Targets:** Willingness to meet ongoing program commitments.
- **Agreement & Compliance:** Ability to sign the program agreement and abide by its terms.

Instructor Commitments

- **Quarterly License Purchases:** Purchase 30 Pearson Skilling Suite licenses per quarter.
- **Annual Program Fee:** Pay a \$250 yearly program membership fee.
- **Profile Maintenance:** Maintain an up-to-date profile on the Pearson Partner Portal.
- **Teaching Demo Submission:** Provide a 20-minute teaching video during onboarding.
